# Endobronchial Valves for Lung Volume Reduction

### WHEN TO REFER A PATIENT

## **Preliminary Screening**

Ideally completed within the last six months:

- Pulmonary Function Tests with plethysmography and diffusion
- 6-minute walk distance
- High resolution non-contrast chest CT
- BMI ≤ 35
- Self-reported nonsmoker (please see reverse side for information on Penn Medicine's Smoking Cessation Program)
- · Medically optimized

### **Pulmonary Function Test Cutoffs:**

- FEV1: >15%, <45%
- TLC: >100%
- RV: >150% (>200% if homogenous disease on imaging evaluation)
- DLCO > 20%

#### 6-Minute Walk Distance:

100-500 meters

If you have patients with emphysema that meet the criteria, we would be happy to evaluate them for lung volume reduction. If you are unsure if your patient meets the above criteria, our general pulmonologists can conduct the preliminary screening.
